



**BGC JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM
IN ASSOCIATION WITH TARUN SARDESAI GOLF**

RULES AND REGULATIONS

BATCHES AND TIMINGS

1. Every Junior will be assigned a day, batch and time based on age and playing ability
2. There will be 4 age groups
 - a. 5-8 years
 - b. 9-12 years
 - c. 13-15 years
 - d. 16-18 years
3. There will be 4 levels within each age group
 - a. Basic
 - b. Intermediate
 - c. Advanced
 - d. Elite
4. We request that the parent understand that it is essential for players to be grouped along with others of similar age and ability for us to be able to bring out the best in him or her
5. Parents are requested to refrain from asking for a change in batch or timings
6. The program will be conducted on all days of the week except Monday
 - a. Saturday and Sunday
 - i. Age groups:
 1. 5-8 years and 9-12 years for all levels
 - ii. Timings:
 1. 7pm-8:30pm, 8:30pm-10pm
 - b. Tuesday to Friday
 - i. Age groups:
 1. 13-15 years and 16-18 years for all levels
 - ii. Timings:
 1. 7pm-8:30pm, 8:30pm-10pm

FEE PAYMENT STRUCTURE

1. Annual registration fee payable every year Rs.1000
2. Program fee will be collected quarterly
 - a. Rs. 4000 per month for members' children
 - b. Rs. 6000 per month for non-members' children



3. All payments will be made directly to the BGC either by cheque, demand draft, credit/debit card, or in the case of a member a direct debit to the latter's account

4. MEMBERS

A direct debit to the BGC account will be made on the 15th of every month. **In case you would like to withdraw from the program, we need to be informed a month in advance of intended withdrawal.**

5. GUESTS

Payments need to be made in the form of cheque only, favoring Karnataka Golf Association. The same has to be handed over to any of the coaches who are a part of the program. **In case you would like to withdraw from the program, we need to be informed a month in advance of intended withdrawal.**

DISCIPLINE

1. Students must be properly attired while playing on golf course/ practicing on the driving range, putting green.
2. Focus, discipline, punctuality and dedication are of prime importance; students must be on time for the classes – there will be no make-up classes.
3. Use of mobile phones by students is prohibited during training and while playing on the golf course.
4. The BGC in consultation with the Director of Instruction of the junior development program can warn and / or impose a penalty of suspension for improper conduct such as swearing and throwing of golf clubs or any other act which may amount to an act contrary to the laid down rules and regulations of golf, breach of local rules, physical confrontation between players etc.
5. The BGC in consultation with the Director of Instruction of the junior development program has the right to suspend or expel any child from the program for misbehavior.
6. The BGC in consultation with the Director of Instruction of the junior development program has the right to refuse renewal of further terms in the program at their discretion.
7. If it is proved that any student of the junior development program has cheated i.e. having knowingly and willingly breached the rules of golf for the sole purpose of improving his/her score /position / ranking in any tournament the following steps will be taken
 - a. The player will be warned and banned for the next 3 events
 - b. If the player is found to have repeated the offence the BGC reserves the right to ban the player from participating in any more tournaments and remove them from the program



WITHDRAWAL / ABSENCE FROM THE PROGRAM

1. Parents wishing to withdraw from the program will need to do so in writing at least 30 days before the start of the next quarter.
2. Withdrawal from the program during a quarter that has already been paid for will not entitle students to any refunds
3. There will be no refund of the registration fee.
4. Students who wish to re-join the program will have to do so as a fresh applicant and pay the registration fee again.
5. Once a student withdraws from the program, he/she will cease to have access to all data / records maintained by me.
6. Any prolonged absence without prior notice to the club, coaching team will be treated as withdrawal from the program.

NOTE: We do understand that there will be family holidays and travel that will cause interruptions to the continuity of your child in the program. Unfortunately due to accounting issues we will not be able to cater for this. We would appreciate that you inform the team by email and support the program by not asking us to change our policies.

7. In the case of fee paid for a particular month and sessions are left unattended, the same will not be adjusted at the time of return.

MISSED CLASS POLICY

Incase of a missed class there will be no make-up classes provided. As this is an ongoing program we expect parents to understand that our investment in the child's game/progress is long-term.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

Students may apply for a leave of absence for the following reasons:

- Death in the family
- Long term injury
- Prolonged illness

In either of the above cases students will need to give in a written application. Once approved by the BGC in consultation with the Director of Instruction the student's account will be frozen and the balance may be used when the student rejoins the program.
