



BANGALORE JUNIOR GOLF TOUR

FAQ'S

1. WHAT IS THE TOUR FEE?

The tour fee is an annual membership fee that takes care of all the administrative costs of running the tour.

2. DO I STILL HAVE TO PAY THE TOUR FEE IF MY CHILD PLAYS IN ONLY 2 EVENTS?

Yes even if your child will play only 2 events the tour fee is mandatory. What you can do is wait for the next year's tour to start if you do not wish to pay the tour fee for just a few events

3. WHY IS THE TOUR FEE INCREASED BY RS 500 THIS YEAR?

As with all things the expenses that we incur increase each year. In the year 2016 we were unable to cover all our expenses hence the increase.

4. WHY ARE THE ENTRY FEES WHAT THEY ARE?

As we are a non funded tour, the entry fees helps us meet our expenses for the tournament including a fee that needs to be paid to the golf clubs who host the events.

5. WHAT IS THE AIM OF THE BANGALORE JUNIOR GOLF TOUR?

The aim of this tour is to give new golfers a feel for tournament golf in the hope that it motivates them to get better. The idea is for them to learn the qualities of patience and integrity so that they can become ambassadors for the sport. The BJGT is a stepping-stone to the South Zone Junior Golf Tour as well.

6. WHY DO MARKERS GO WITH THE E CATEGORY BUT NO OTHER CATEGORY?

The E category players are too young to accurately record their scores so we send an adult marker with them. The idea is for them to slowly learn the process of counting and writing down their scores. Once a player is in the D category and above it should not take them more than a few tournaments to learn the ropes.

7. WHAT IS THE TOUR CHAMPIONSHIP?



The Tour Championship is the final event of the year and focuses on rewarding the players who have worked hard and featured in the top 5 of the order of merit. They will be invited for a final tournament where will get all categories to play 18 holes over 2 days. This will also give the E category players the experience of playing a full round.

8. WHAT FACILITES DO YOU HAVE TO TAKE CARE ON INJURIES ON COURSE

Every golf course has a tie up with a local hospital and in the event of any mishaps players can be treated at these hospitals.

9. WHY ARE PARENTS NOT ALLOWED TO WALK ON THE COURSE

Unfortunately we have seen that many parents cannot resist the temptation to give advice to their kids or caddies while they are playing. As it is very difficult for us to single out these parents we have had to make a blanket rule in the interest of the sport.

10. HOW DOES ONE ENTER A TOURNAMENT

Parents have to stay in touch with the website calendar and see if there is a tournament that has been announced. Every tournament that is announced automatically generates an email that is sent to the registered email address. The player can then log in to the website using his / her credentials and register for the tournament.

11. WHAT HAPPENS IF THE LAST DATE OF REGISTRATION IS OVER

In case the last date of registration is over you can send a mail to tournaments@tsgolf.in with a request to register your child.

13. WHO CAN I CONTACT IN CASE I AM UNABLE TO ENTER THROUGH THE WEBSITE

14. DO YOU HAVE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE TOUR



Yes we have a rules and regulations document, which we usually send to every parent in the beginning of the year.

15. WHY IS THERE A DIFFERENT FEE FOR DIFFERENT CLUBS

The cost of running the tournament varies from club to club and sometimes we have to increase the entry fee accordingly.

16. DOES EVERY CHILD WALK AWAY WITH SOMETHING

Every child will get a certificate of participation for taking part in an event.

17. WHAT HAPPENS IF I CANCEL THE ENTRY LAST MINUTE

If you cancel the entry at the last minute there is nothing that we can do, but please know that it causes a lot of administrative problems for us. This is part of running a junior tour and we accept it.

18. WHAT SHOULD I DO IF A CADDIE / PARENT IS HARRASING OR BEING RUDE TO MY CHILD

Please send us an email describing the incident to tournaments@tsgolf.in We will take it up with the parties concerned or call for a meeting with all the parties concerned to resolve the issue.

19. WHY IS THE REPORTING TIME SO EARLY

Junior golf tournaments are very time consuming and in order to be able to finish the tournament on time we have to start early. The club committees usually like to be present for the prize distributions and if we finish too late they are usually not able to make it.

20. WHY DOES THE ORDER OF MERIT TAKE SO LONG TO LOAD

As the website calculates the order of merit each time the button is pressed, it takes time to load. As this is a new website we are working on the same and hopefully we will have a solution soon

21. IS THE ORDER OF MERIT SEPARATE FOR BOYS AS WELL AS GIRLS

Yes the OOM is separate for boys and girls. Currently it loads both boys and girls together but you have to select which gender you want to see.
